His age being labelled as "4XX" may be an intentional joke, as "XX" is "20" in Roman numerals; if it is intentional, this would make him 420 years old. He has the fewest personal Secret Endings in Monster Prom, at only two. Most official artwork depicts Liam as left-handed. If this is canon, he shares this trait with Vera Oberlin[25], and possibly Scott Howl and Polly Geist. As mentioned in a multiplayer-exclusive weekend event, Liam lives in a "beautiful and minimalistically decorated" apartment. Liam claims to despise "low culture",[11] but it is actually his quilty pleasure. [20] "Low culture" is a term for forms of popular culture with mass appeal. It is described as emphasizing morality, limited to familial and individual problems, or the experience of living vicariously through viewing another's life; it is also thought of as formulaic and employing trope conventions and stock characters and archetypes in simplistic ways, compared to "high culture's" perceived subtle, refined, or open-for-interpretation implementations.
